the book the miracle of ahmad i j□z e ahmadi is one of the signs of truthfulness of the founder of ahmadiyya muslim community it was written in 1902 when an opponent in mudh india alleged that all prophecies made by hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as were false and that he did not possess the miraculous knowledge of the arabic language he had claimed in response the promised messiah as wrote this book containing a lengthy arabic qas□dah ode in praise of the holy prophet muhammad may peace and blessings of allah be upon him in a mere five days he challenged his opponents to produce the like of it and announced a prize money of rs 10 000 which was his total worth at the time no one arose to the challenge instead a large number of residents of town of mudh were decimated by the plague as prophesied in this book

how can a false claimant of prophethood be likened to me i have been supported by numerous miracles my success is from god and is a fulfillment of his promises it is not within the control of any human being to this simple message is a gift for an nadwah dedicated in this short and incisive tract hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as responds to the contention made by hafiz muhammad yusuf that even false claimants of prophethood can establish successful missions through the use of this critique muhammad yusuf hoped to undermine the success of the promised messiah as with strong reasoned arguments hadrat mirza ghulam ahmad as deconstructs this thesis and exposes its inherent flaws and defects he argues that false prophets can never succeed and that to hold such beliefs is a direct contradiction of the teachings of islam instead the triumph of god s messengers is a miracle and a divine sign in support of their truth the principle audience of this work were the ulema of an nadwah who were called on by hafiz muhammad yusuf to judge the merits of these contending claims

pandit lekh ram a leader of the aryam samaj challenged hadrat mirza ghulam ahmad the promised messiah as to make a prophecy against him as proof of islam s truth the promised messiah as accepted predicting lekh ram s death within six years of 20 february 1893 and specifying it would occur close to eid lekh ram mocked the prophecy and continued to insult islam and the holy prophet sa however on 6 march 1897 the day after eid lekh ram was murdered in broad daylight before close family and friends exactly as prophesied the aryam samaj shocked by the accuracy accused the promised messiah as of conspiracy to murder leading to widespread backlash against the promised messiah as while muslim opponents like sheikh muhammad husain of batala dismissed the prophecy as mere coincidence in response the promised messiah as wrote istifta a verdict required on may 1897 requesting scholars to assess the evidence documented in his books and issue a verdict he encouraged them to courageously stand up for truth and expressed his intention to eventually translate the work into english to allow europeans to investigate the matter for themselves and draw their own conclusions in light of the facts

the writings elucidate many of islamic teachings this book contains excerpts of his writings with topics ranging from allah to life after death the original text has been provided alongside the english translation

the diamond jubilee of her majesty queen victoria was celebrated with great pomp and show in june 1897 throughout british india since the purpose of the advent of the promised messiah as was to propagate the unity of god and his message he found a way to serve those objectives at that occasion he published the booklet tohfa e qaisariyyah on may 25 1897 in addition to felicitating her majesty the promised messiah as made the following points with great subtlety and wisdom 1 truthfulness of the holy prophet muhammad sa 2 truthfulness of islam and its teachings that can bring about international peace 3 a proposal for her majesty to organise a conference of great religions 4 a strong plea for her majesty to clear hazrat isa as jesus of the accusation of having been cursed 5 an undertaking to show a sign of his own truthfulness provided that her majesty would agree to accept his message in case of fulfilment adding that he would accept death penalty if he is unable to show a convincing sign

held under the auspices of hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad the promised messiah and mahdi as february 2 1900 was the day of eidul fitr hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as the promised messiah and mahdi advised the members of the jama at to hold a meeting on that day and offer prayers for the success of the british government in his address he commented on the chapter an naas of the holy qur an and reminded the audience of the duties they owed to the government especially because of the goodness of the government which it had displayed in various ways after the address he told the gathering to pray for the victory of the british government in the battle that was being fought in transvaal and then led a silent prayer for this purpose some amount was collected to be sent for the injured in this battle this gathering of the jama at came to be known as the prayer meeting
